Space and Dimensions:

Adequate site dimensions are necessary to accommodate the mobile unit and any additional facilities, such as walkways or modular connections.*

Utilities: The site must have access to essential utilities, including electrical supply, water, medical gases, and drainage systems.

*All setups are subject to a site survey.

Telecommunications: Reliable communication infrastructure is required to ensure smooth operations.

Accessibility: The location should allow for easy access for patients, staff, and equipment. This might include pathways or integral walkways connecting to existing hospital buildings.

Custom Configurations:

Depending on the surgical needs, the theatre can include features like anaesthetic rooms, recovery areas, and advanced imaging equipment.*
