

Doncaster and Bassetlaw Teaching Hospitals became the first acute NHS provider to successfully eradicate reinforced autoclaved aerated concrete (RAAC) from its sites

While undergoing roof refurbishment work, **Bassetlaw Hospital's** operating theatres could not be used.

Three Vanguard mobile theatres, alongside modular support buildings to house storage, welfare and changing facilities, allowed essential procedures to continue while this important work was carried out.

In just 10 weeks, a solution was designed, installed and commissioned, including the construction of a connecting corridor and firewalls.

Clinical training was provided for staff who would run and maintain the facility day-to-day.

Planned general, breast and laser surgery went ahead, as did arthroplasty, orthopaedic foot, shoulder and hand surgery, and urological, gynaecological, and endoscopy procedures.










