The need for Community Diagnostic Centres


Acute and non-acute diagnostic services are under increasing pressure to meet growing demand.

To combat this, new and radical service models such as Community Diagnostic Centres (CDCs) are needed to separate acute and elective diagnostics.

Community Diagnostic Centres are a flexible solution to help health systems tackle their non-acute diagnostics requirements.

CDCs create centres for non-acute diagnostics away from acute hospitals, including at community hospitals or primary care settings.

Providing services away from facilities used for urgent diagnostic scans means shorter waiting times and a reduced risk of cancellation which can happen when the more urgent cases take priority.

Meeting the community's needs, exactly and soon

Using modern methods of construction, Vanguard helps healthcare providers establish high quality CDCs within the shortest time.

This modular construction also means that the building can be easily reconfigured as the needs of the community change and different diagnostic services are required.

Modular construction enables Vanguard to build around 80% of a Community Diagnostic Centre away from the construction site, at the Vanguard factory in Hull, while the ground works are being completed.

The time saved by this concurrent working is one of the benefits of modern methods of construction. Others include reduced traffic at the construction site, the protection from weather related delays, greater efficiency, and better quality control.

Modules can be delivered to the construction site and installed in just a few days, before finishing and commissioning.

Vanguard's facilities can be providing diagnostic services within weeks

Vanguard's mobile facilities enable healthcare providers to offer diagnostic services in the community as soon as the decision to do so has been made, even before the construction of a CDC commences.

On the sites where CDCs were being built, University Hospitals of Leicester NHS Trust and Sherwood Forest Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust installed Vanguard's relocatable endoscopy complexes, giving them a head start in meeting the needs of their communities.

These mobile or relocatable facilities can also reduce the construction time and the capital outlay for building a CDC, when integrated with a modular building that provides, for example, reception and waiting areas, wards, pathology and laboratory space, plant room, storage and staff welfare areas.

Vanguard's unique capability to integrate modular and mobile facilities, enables healthcare providers to meet patients' needs and operate within restrictions such as budget limits and tight deadlines.

Great Western Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust builds a new community diagnostic hub providing more than 6,000 extra endoscopy appointments.

The additional appointments are being made available to patients across Swindon and Wiltshire thanks to a new endoscopy unit, built by Vanguard, using modern methods of construction, next to the existing West Swindon Health Centre, in a busy community location, close to the local leisure centre.

The facility is being built using modules which have been designed and manufactured by Vanguard at its factory in Hull. Specialising in the provision of healthcare facilities, Vanguard has worked with the Trust to tailor the building to the needs of the community.
