Our mobile endoscopy facilities are fully integrated to provide complete pathways for patients and equipment. These high-quality facilities can be used to perform a range of diagnostic and therapeutic procedures.

They can include a reception, admission and discharge areas, consulting rooms, procedure rooms, patient bays and WC, staff WC, and a refreshment area plus a whole range of other optional features.

These JAG compliant facilities allow for oneway flow of endoscopes ensuring that clean and dirty scopes never come into contact with each other.

Our facilities are supplied with the latest Automated Endoscope Reprocessors (AERs) with some of the quickest process times available thus ensuring high volume, quick turnaround capacity, enabling the achievement of +48 JAG points per day.





Our mobile endoscopy suites are available in single or dual procedure-room options, with or without decontamination facilities for flexible endoscope reprocessing. They provide a spacious, climate-controlled work environment with natural light, designed and equipped in consultation with frontline staff.

They can be installed in a matter of hours and become operational following a short commissioning period. Depending on the selected model, our clients can achieve in excess of 24 or 48 JAG (Joint Advisory Group) points per day.

Our modular solutions enable infinite flexibility, and offer a faster, more environmentally-friendly, less disruptiveand cost-effective alternative to traditional building methods.

The buildings we construct offer limitless potential to create totally unique and specifically tailored healthcare spaces, offering a compliant way to boost clinical capacity or manage clinical challenges.







Decontamination

Our endoscope decontamination facilities offer an ideal decant facility during refurbishments, or help hospitals perform capacity and service development programmes.

All our facilities are HTM compliant, and depending on the selected model can process 90 or 120 scopes per ten-hour day.

Our Healthcare Spaces offer spacious, climate-controlled, naturally lit work environments. They arrive fully equipped, following consultations between your clinicians and ours.

Mobile facilities can be installed in a matter of hours and operational following a short commissioning period. Endoscope decontamination facilities include double endoscope sinks, drying cabinets, transport trolleys, and up to four AERs. Staff changing and welfare areas are included, as are a WC, scope reprocessing rooms and a technical room.

Facilities built using modular construction provide infinite design flexibility and can be open within weeks.





Vanguard helped Frimley Health NHS Foundation Trust increase capacity for endoscopy procedures through the innovative use of a bespoke modular solution at Wexham Park Hospital, Slough.

The bespoke modular solution, designed by Vanguard alongside Frimley Health NHS Foundation Trust, was built as a 'one-stop' solution which incorporates not only two high quality clinical procedure rooms but also an in-house endoscope decontamination suite.

The building also includes a reception and waiting area, two consultation rooms, a six bed recovery bay, patient facilities and kitchen, staff welfare and plant, technical and storage rooms.

The modular building, created from 46 single units, was completed in a little under two months.

Since opening, this bespoke modular solution created by Vanguard has seen high volumes of patients every day, performing a range of endoscopy procedures including colonoscopies, sigmoidoscopies and gastroscopies.

Wexford General Hospital experienced extensive damage in a devastating fire, leaving it in need of significant construction and electrical works. Endoscopy procedures were one of the services impacted.

Any extended suspension of these essential procedures would have had extremely negative effects. So, while rebuilding work was undertaken, a Vanguard mobile endoscopy suite provided a 'one-stop' facility from reception, consultation, procedure and recovery as well as providing an internal decontamination facility.

The Vanguard mobile endoscopy facility allowed clinicians to deliver procedures equivalent to 18 JAG points per day (plus two emergencies), operating an average of five days a week, with additional sessions every second Saturday. The team performs a range of procedures including colonoscopies, gastroscopies and sigmoidoscopies.

The process of having the facility delivered and installed was seamless and very quick. The people on site during that process were very helpful and there was training delivered by Vanguard for our staff.

With Hampshire Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust having a significant number of patients who required endoscopy treatment, the team at Basingstoke Hospital wanted to make radical changes and ensure prompt treatment.

Vanguard worked with the hospital's clinical and estates teams, identifying exactly what was required for the success of the initiative and enabling the setting of realistic and achievable timescales.

A mobile endoscopy suite, delivered and operational within two weeks, provided a high-quality clinical environment, specifically equipped to meet the needs of the hospital.

This additional capacity enabled the hospital to achieve its JAG accreditation, in particular the timeliness component of the Endoscopy Global Rating Scale (GRS), treating 1800 patients at a rate of around eighty procedures per week.

The hospital reduced waiting lists to almost zero for these procedures and reported that patient feedback was positive and a testament to the project's success.

"Managing such a high volume of patients was essential if we were to develop our endoscopy facilities and ultimately achieve JAG accreditation. However, we were not willing to compromise our high standard of patient care, hence the decision to use a mobile endoscopy suite. This allowed us to deliver the same level of service as that in the hospital."


